


# **Program Updates**

- Expand the MOAA brand with custom websites offering secure payment processing.
- Simplify tracking payments, collecting information from members, and record keeping.
- Provide a tangible resource from MOAA National to our affiliates to help promote chapter membership.




- New solution for chapter/council dues payments
- Secure, PCI-compliant system
- Processed \$450M+
- Clients include American Heart Association, PTAs, Girl Scouts, Rotary Clubs, etc
- Multi-faceted options to help address chapter/council needs

#### **MOAA** National Support

- MOAA National contract with Cheddar Up; free to chapters and councils
- MOAA National will cover individual transaction fees
- Staff assistance to get setup with custom website
- Initial focus on dues (other functionality available)



# **Making Payments**


- Allow for different dues structures and donations.
- Collect credit card payments and track cash and check payments.
- Collect payments online or onsite with the app and a Bluetooth card reader (\$79).
- Members do not need an account.

## **Customize the Experience**

- Customize receipts to include membership information
- Send messages with dues or event reminders, etc.
- Set up for recurring payments/auto renew
- Create discount codes to promote membership
- Include a link to make donations to the chapter
- Let members order meal selection or purchase tickets in advance of meetings and events

# What's Entailed in Getting Started

- Identify primary and secondary administrators
- Set up bank account in system
- Clarify dues structure and amounts
- Provide access to MOAA staff who will build the dues form
- Execute test transaction
- Execute test disbursement
- Embed link to dues page on chapter/council website
- MOAA to set up link to dues page on a new Chapter Dues page on the MOAA website
