Effective Councils

- Represent the consensus of member chapters
- Mentor chapter leaders
- Provide a forum for exchange of ideas
- Lead and coordinate state legislative matters in interest of the military and veteran community
- Support MOAA's legislative and other priorities
- Visit chapters, participate in virtual meetings
- Help monitor and maintain healthy affiliate system of chapters



Effective Chapters

- Have a clearly stated chapter purpose/mission statement
- Focus on leadership pipeline and best practices
- Impact legislation through advocacy and engagement
- Engage in impactful community service
- Promote membership growth through recruitment and retention

- 4. Be opted-in to receive communications from national MOAA, to include the MOAA Newsletter




New Leader's Checklist



Effective Membership



- Create a nonpartisan, inclusive community
- Welcome diverse perspectives
- Convey the value of membership
- Recruit, retain, and recognize members
- Communicate relevant information effectively
- Host meaningful events

Member Data: Committee Module and the Near Real Time Report

- Committee Module
 - View/edit/add/remove members and officers from MOAA's roster
- Near Real Time Report (NRT)
 - Access list of prospective members in your catchment area
 - Ability to search in 3-month increments
- Nov 21 Monthly Leaders Roundtable will focus on CM and NRT Training



Membership Recruitment

- Annual Recruiting Incentive
 - Chapters receive money annually from MOAA for chapter members who become paid PREMIUM or LIFE MOAA members (\$15/\$30).
- Chapter Voucher Program
 - New MOAA paid members receive a voucher for a free chapter trial period in their new member letters. MOAA will reimburse chapters \$15/\$30 for any vouchers accepted.

New Award Application Process

- SurveyMonkey Apply for Organizational Awards
 - \circ New centralized platform
 - \odot Dec 1 Feb 15 application/nomination window
 - Criteria is largely the same, database scoring has been removed from LOE this year
 - \circ Dec 19 Monthly Leaders Roundtable will focus on new platform



New Chapter Dues Portal: Goals

- Make joining a chapter/council or renewing membership easy.
- Reduce administrative burden of volunteer leaders.
- Expand the MOAA brand with custom websites offering secure payment processing.
- Simplify tracking payments, collecting information from members, and record keeping.
- Provide a tangible resource from MOAA National to our affiliates to help promote chapter membership.

MOAA National Support

- MOAA National will cover individual transaction fees
- Staff assistance to get set-up with custom website
- Initial focus on dues (other functionality available)





Total Registered Advocates: 291 (58/20% from Chapter or Council Members) Total Actions Taken: 1459 (143/10% from Chapter or Council Members)




MOAA Foundation Crisis Relief Program

- Donations welcome!


